New Hope Clinic was recently the recipient of three different grants that will help us to upgrade and expand the services we currently provide to our patients.

Catherine Kennedy Grant

New Hope Clinic, Inc., along with several other community nonprofit organizations, was honored at The Catherine Kennedy Home Foundation's 2015 Grants Reception and Awards, held at the Cameron Center in Wilmington.

Grant funding from The Catherine Kennedy Home Foundation makes it possible for New Hope Clinic to continue to provide individualized healthcare and wellness support for NHC's senior patients. This support includes providing guidelines to the patients and their families to help them become more educated and involved in their own health and wellness, educational materials to help patients and their families learn how to manage their chronic diseases such as diabetes and COPD, durable medical equipment, and help planning for their transition to having Medicare coverage.

Pharmacy Upgrade Grant

The New Hope Clinic pharmacy is a busy place. Last year our all-volunteer pharmacy team filled 12,788 30-day prescriptions! We need to make sure that our equipment can handle the heavy workload. That's why we recently updated our pharmacy computer system. With the help of funding from Sea Trail Garden Club, St. Philip's Men's Club Mission Fund, and private donations we have just purchased and installed an updated printer, pharmacy software, and prescription bottle labels that will provide faster printer response, better print quality and be easier to maintain and supply.
